The <u>United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues (UNPFII)</u> is a forum mandated to address issues faced by Indigenous Peoples related to economic and social development, culture, environment, health, and human rights. More specifically, UNPFII:

- provides expert advice and recommendations on indigenous issues to the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC)
- raises awareness and promotes the integration and coordination of activities related to indigenous issues within the UN system
- prepares and disseminates information on issues faced by Indigenous Peoples • promotes respect for and full application of the provisions of the UN Declaration on the Rights of
- **Indigenous Peoples** and its followup
