### **STUDENTS COMMUNITY IN NORTH & EAST IS TERRIFIED**

Parts of Sri Lanka, namely North and East are becoming a deadly place for the students, teachers or education officials. Attacks on education often escape international attention amid the general fighting in conflict-affected countries. However, the number of reported assassinations and intimidation, bombings and burnings of school and academic staff and buildings has risen dramatically in the past three years, reflecting the increasingly bloody nature of local conflicts around Sri Lanka. I strongly suggest that the worst-affected Schools, Colleges, Universities and other academic Institutions that should be safe havens for children, have increasingly become the prime target of attacks by armed parties.

The students in the North and East of Sri Lanka are highly at stake. The Government continues not only to be indifferent to establish security measures against the massive death threat mounting on the students community but also it promotes the underworld activities by using its collaborating paramilitary viz. EPDP and Karuna Faction. Systematic suppression of Judiciary and the law enforcement authorities; Geographical set up of Jaffna Peninsula, PTA, Emergency Regulation, Multi-presence of Military, infiltration of LTTE into Government controlled area, activities of the Paramilitary have been hampering the study programme of the students in North and East. This is a part of the package deal of the Government to suppress the study programme of the students in the North and East. In the LTTE controlled area, the students are terrorised by forcible recruitment, intimidation and restriction in freedom of movement and expression. Students are abducted and recruited by the LTTE. In totality, the students in the Government controlled area and in the LTTE controlled area are equally threatened for different purpose.

I try to focus on targeted violent attacks, carried out for political, military, ideological, sectarian, ethnic or religious reasons, against students, teachers, academics, education officials and all those who work in or for education institutions such as schools, colleges and universities.

I would like to draw your kind attention on the students who are exposed to grave danger in Jaffna in particular and North and East in General. The students who are abducted are missing forever.

How ever, the students w ho are abducted and forcibly recruited by the LTTE are given a chance to visit the family members after 3 months of arms training.

The focus here is the student community is terrified and the government while remaining passive perpetrators, promotes the active perpetrators to fetter the study programme of the students. It is the prime duty of the state to protect the children as it has signed the CRC. The Government of Sri Lanka is keen on expelling the Tamil intellectuals and educationists. They have a hidden agenda to execute to reduce the literacy rate of the Tamils. Strenuous effort of the Government to jeopardise the study programme of the Tamil students is successfully underway. The LTTE is on the other hand is keen on choking the intellectuals and the educationists who have pluralistic views and promote alternatives opinions.

### **Death Threats to the Academic Staff and to the Students in Jaffna**

Almost every nook and corner in Jaffna is tightly secured by the security forces. Thanks for their security services. How ever, enormous doubt arises in everybody's mind is that how is it possible for those who distribute the threat notices to the students and to the academic staff in the presence of the security forces. The suspicions snowball and force everyone to conclude that the threat fliers are distributed either by the security forces or by those who are employed shortly by the security forces (Paramilitary).

Unwarranted interference of the armed men, escalating intimidation to the students, indifferent approach of the Government to the non-violent claim of the students to stop violence over students have paved a way to consistently curtail academic programme of the students. The students have amply expressed their concern to the responsible authorities. Once again, I would like to draw your attention on the students of North and East of Sri Lanka.

Both the Government and the LTTE are exploiting the student community to achieve their short term and long term, petty and selfish goals.

Attached below is the flier issued to the university students by the **unknown gunmen** in the heavy presence of the security forces in the University of Jaffna on May 8, 2007.

### **Protect the dignity of the School Uniform**

*Those of you who wearing the school uniform and joining the terrorists, were involved in terrorist activities, we give you a final warning!*

*Our organization has received information that you have joined with Kuhan (Satha), Kunenthiran (Kuna), Kannan, Iniyavan, and Anutheepan (Jeya) who belong to the terrorist organization and believing their attractive words have received arms training, and have been connected with or involved in terrorist activities like carrying weapons in your book bags; hiding and keeping pistol, grenade, claymore; undertaking grenade attack; organizing struggle by boycotting of classes; setting fire to tyres or buses; forced selling of the magazine call 'Salaram' to the students.*

*We have taken a decision to meet out the death penalty to such traitors like you. However, because you are school students, we have decided to give you one and only one chance.*

*Ignoring the guidance of your parents full of love for you, and joining the terrorists and without thinking about your life, if you involve yourselves in further destructive activities, we have to reluctantly inform you that we shall certainly execute the death penalty.*

*Parents! Do not permit your children to be involved in terrorist activities.*

*Principal and the teachers! Watch over the activities of the students. Show them the right path.*

*"Tamil Alliance for the Defense of the country (Sri Lanka)*

*Jaffna District"*

*"Let us die if the motherland is not there; we shall win."*

**Attached is a complaint lodged with Human Rights Commission of Sri Lanka at Jaffna Regional Branch on May 12, 2007. This is an evidence how the academic staff are tortured, intimidated, threatened and abducted in Jaffna.**

On May 4, 2007 Friday, at about 11.40 in the night, many armed unidentified persons came into my house compound jumping over the wall. While many stood surrounding my house, many others entered my house breaking our door and attacked me. They threatened my wife at the point of weapons and locked her in a room telling her not to come out. They then arrested me, took me out of the house, tied my hands behind me and also blindfolded me and attacked me. Then they themselves took my motor cycle out. Then they took me on motorcycle to another place and arrested the brother of my wife from their house. After some hours and after my hearing the cries of my brother in law, they transferred me to another place. They were threatening me not to tell anyone of my arrest and torture inflicted on me. Then they untied my hands and unfolded my eyes. Having released me at the College Street, they handed over my motorcycle to me and warned me not to turn and look. I did not lodge any complaints with police and army about abduction and torture due to fear. Later, again on May 10, 2007 Thursday, a leaflet containing murder threat, mentioning many names including mine was delivered in a cover through an unidentified person to the Principal, teachers and school development society.

Therefore I humbly request you to do the needful to ensure my security

**1. I received a complaint from Kuharajan Meera the elder sister of the Kannan Kuharajan:**

My brother Kannan Kuharajan, age 18, is a student of St. John's College, Jaffna. At about 7.30 in the night (4th May 2007) when curfew was in force, we heard the noise of someone knocking on our house door. We were then watching TV. At that time we heard someone standing outside the edge of the window of that room saying "This is the person. Kannan is there."

Then they asked us to open the rear door, and when we opened it, two persons entered the house through that door. At the same time, three others forced open the front door and came in. One of

those who came by the rear door wore a helmet, a butter colour checked shirt and a beige colour trousers.

He came into the room where we had been watching TV and covered his face with a white cloth that was there. Then he took the money (Rs.15,000.00) from my father's trouser pocket and his mobile phone from the table. He had a pistol in his hand. After looking around that room, he came out to my younger brother Kannan and asked him "In which school do you study?" and "Where is your father working?"

He spoke good and fluent Tamil. When he called my brother to talk, he called him stammering a little as "Ka Ka Kannan"

One of those who came wore a T-shirt coloured green as of cow dung and black boots. He said 'I will send him after finishing the inquiry'. The one with the helmet said "Don't shout. We will release him in 2 or 3 days after the inquiry. When they were about to take Kannan, he said "Appa (dad), you too come" and held his father's hand. They took also our father Kuharaja. I saw them taking Kannan and our father up to the gate.

My father later told us that they took them both (Kannan and father) up to the Hindu College Junction and there keeping a pistol on my father's stomach told him "You go back. We guarantee the life of your son. We will return him." and sent him back. It was when the curfew was in effect they entered the house. I request you humbly to do all the needful to get my younger brother released.

**2. I received a complaint from Mrs. Kamaleswary Nagarajah, the mother of Mr. Nagarajah Venuganan:**

I received a complaint from Mrs. Kamaleswary Nagarajah of No.6, 1<sup>st</sup>, Lane, Brown Road, Neeraviyady, Jaffna. Mrs. Kamaleswary Nagarajah is the mother of Mr. Nagarajah Venuganan (20 yrs) who is an A/L student of Jaffna Hindu College. On May 4, 2007 around 11 pm, while we were on bed, a group of gunmen broke open the door and aggressively entered into the house. They



ordered us not to switch on the lights. They asked for my son Nagarajah Venuganan and took him saying that they wanted to inquire him. They told us that they would conduct the inquiry at the temple and then would release him immediately. There were 6 armed men. They came in motorbikes and in a van. They locked the gates and ordered us not to get out of the house. It was when the curfew was in effect they entered the house.

May I request you to help find the whereabouts of my son. She has lodged a complaint with the Human Rights Commission in Jaffna. The reference number is HRC/J/MP/07/756. Human Rights Commission has sent letters to the following requesting to help them find the whereabouts of the victim.

**3. I received a complaint from Mr. Kanapathipillai Suntharalingam, the father of Mr. Suntharalingam Yasotharan:**

Mr. Kanapathipillai Suntharalingam of 56, Kalaivani Mill Lane, Kokuvil East, Kokuvil, Jaffna told me that his son Mr. Suntharalingam Yasotharan (18) was an A/L student of Jaffna Hindu College. On May 4, 2007 at midnight a group of armed men who came on motorbikes took my son with them. They entered the house aggressively and asked for my son by his name. It was when the curfew was in effect they entered the house. Some of the armed men were wearing Army (Camouflage) uniform and the rest were in civil dress. The gunmen forced the father and the mother of the boy into a room of the house and locked it. They ordered the not to come out of the room before 5 am. He told me that there was an army sentry point 100 meters away from his house.

He has already lodged a complaint with the Human Rights Commission of Jaffna Region. The reference number is **HRC/J/MP/07/755**. Human Rights Commission has sent letters to the following requesting to help them find the whereabouts of the victim.

**4. I received a complaint from Mrs. Thavarajah Varaladsumy, the mother of Mr. Thavarajah Nivarsan:**

On March 14, 2007, Friday Mr. Thavarajah Nivarsan helped and Vickneswaran Subasharan (39 yrs), father of three, to take his lorry to the garage at Kopay. Thavarajah Nivarsan helped Vickneswaran Subasharan to pull the break-down lorry to the garage with the lorry owned by his father. On March 18, 2007 Sunday, the brother of Nivarsan called Nimalan wanted to go to the tuition centre. Nivarsan took his brother on the motorbike owned by V. Subasharan. Nivarsan dropped his brother at the tuition Centre at 7 am and returned home. Having dropped his brother at the tuition centre he handed over the Motor bike to V. Subasharan. On the day itself, he wanted to go with Subasharan to the garage at Kopay to check whether the work was completed. Both Subasharan and Nivarsan set out to the Garage at Kopay at 7:30 am from Manthuvil. They went on a motor bike belong to Sarmilan (Reg No: NPHH9468), a friend and relative of Nivarsan.

Subasharan is a businessman and he used to transport some essential goods to Manthuvil. According to the passers-by, especially the people who travelled on a bus at 1 pm, they saw both of them at Pungangulam Junction at the check point of the Sri Lankan Army. Both of them are reported missing.

Mrs. Thavarajah Varaladsumy has lodged a complaint with the Human Rights Commission in Jaffna. The reference number is HRC/J/MP/07/714. Human Rights Commission has sent letters to the following requesting to help them find the whereabouts of the victim.

**FINAL WARNING TO THOSE TERRORISTS WHO FUNCTION  
HIDING BEHIND THE CLOAK OF THE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS**

We strongly condemn and deny the leaflet released using the name of our organization in order to destroy the education of innocent University students.

We are in receipt of the details of the true terrorists.

*Purusothman, Kanthan, Vijayaruban, Rajaluxman, Niruban, Thusikanthan, Jeyanthan, Nilrubaraj)Kokkuvil).#*

*You have arranged for lodging arrangements for the terrorists Kuhan(Satha), Kuna(Kunenthiran) in the University Hostel, given arms training to innocent university students, involved school students in terrorist activities, and involved in anti-national activities like hiding claymore, grenade and guns within the university premises, celebrating awareness days in favour of the terrorists, setting buses on fire and conducting boycotting struggles.*

*For you who have disturbed the education of innocent university students and school students and destroyed the future of the Tamil society, there is no punishment other than the death penalty. Students! We expect you to shine out as citizens gaining honour to our Nation and our race. Do not destroy your life by involving in terrorist activities. Being the educational community, function as the correct guides.*

*“Tamil Alliance for the Defense of the country  
Jaffna District”*

*“Let us die if the motherland is not there; we shall win.”*

### **University Students are Murdered**

Consecutive killings of the university students have caused uncertainty of life warrant. The students are in dead fear. Enormous amount of pressure is inflicted on the students to dismantle their morality and psychosocial condition of the students.

1. The brother of **Sinnaiah Sivashankar**, of Vellam Pokkaddi, Kodikamam, Jaffna reported us as follows regarding the death of his brother:

“I, Sinnaiah Sivakumar, aged 33, of Vellam Pokkaddi, Kodikamam, Jaffna holder of NIC No. 732010360 V, being a Hindu, do hereby solemnly, sincerely and truly declare and affirm as follows:

I am the brother of **Mr.Sinnaiah Sivashankar**. He was born on December 30, 2006 and holder of the NIC No.823560264V and stayed at the Jaffna University Boy's Hostel. He was a third year university student attached to the Faculty of Science, University of Jaffna and his registration number in the university is 2003 / SP / 77.

He last left the University hostel last on August 15, 2006 at around 12.20 p.m with one of his friends to buy a soft drink at a nearby shop. When both of them were drinking the soft drink, some unknown gunmen came in a motorbike indiscriminately fired gunshots towards the shop. My brother Mr.Sinnaiah Sivashankar and his friend died on the spot.

The body of my brother was handed over to us after the magisterial inquest on August 16, 2006. We reported about this incident to the Human Rights Commission (Jaffna) on October 10, 2006. He is a person of good character and has never been involved in any illegal, criminal or subversive activities. He had no connections whatsoever with any armed group. No one has been arrested in connection with this killing so far. As the result of the death of my brother, we, the family members are traumatized and distressed very much and are suffering both physically and mentally.”

2. Regarding the Killing of **Krishnan Kamalathas**, a university student of Jaffna, Faculty of Arts, University of Jaffna, holding the registration Number of 2002/ A / 50 the mother reported us as follows:

“Krishnan Kamalathas, of Thavalai, Iyattali, Kodikamam, Jaffna, aged 26, born on February 5, 1981, holding the NIC of 810363193V was staying with me. He used to go to the university from home. He was a tutor. He conducted private classes on economics for the A/L students. He was on his way to conduct classes in a house at Varany, Kodihamam, Jaffna. The people from the village informed us that they had seen him been stopped near the Varany army camp. The same people who told us that the army had asked him to return home. He did so. While he was returning home, some unknown gunmen dressed in shirts and trousers opened fire at him. He was killed on the spot. He was shot dead at 6:15 am on February 18, 2007.”

3. Regarding the Killing of **Selvaratnam Sivaranjan**, a university student of Jaffna, Faculty of Arts, University of Jaffna, holding the registration Number of **20005/ASPI/045** his friends reported us as follows:

“Selvaratnam Sivaranjan, born on September 2, 1984, aged 23, an Art Faculty student of the University of Jaffna was gun down at Chavakachcheri hospital premises during when curfew was enforced strictly. His father is dead. His mother and three sisters were living amidst great financial strains. In order to help his family members he was working as an assistant to a building contractor. He has been working hard to look after the helpless family. He could manage with the daily wage to look after the family and to look into his educational expenses. This incident has taken place at time when the teaching – learning activities of the university have just begun. Such incidents still loom as a life threat to the university students. University students observed a non-violent boycott in condolence of this butchered student. Vice chancellor, Deans of the faculties and

lectures also attend this meeting of condolence. The vice chancellor of the university proclaimed his helplessness with regard to the safety of students within and without the university premises, and this proclamation has stirred aggravated embracement amidst the student population.”

### **University Employee Gunned Down**

**Muththu Peter**, a sanitary employee of the University of Jaffna, on his way back after visiting his mother at Navatkulli was shot dead down Chemmani Road, Nayanmarkattu by unknown gunmen on 31/01/2007 around 5.45 pm, in broad day light. Muthur Peter leaves his widow and a six-month-old infant and the university staff staged one day boycott against this atrocity. Employers union collects the money from the employees to welfare of Peter’s child.

### **University Students are Abducted and Severely Tortured**

The following university students are abducted in the recent past.

1. **Markandu Sasikumar**, aged 25, faculty of arts, University of Jaffna, registration number 2002 / A / 140 was abducted in November 18 , 2006. He is from ward no 4, Delft, Jaffna. He was born on December 14, 1982. He holds a special army Identity Card (No. 0984000147) issued for the people at Delft. He went to Pungudutheivu Navy camp to obtain Military clearance to go out of Jaffna. He left the navy camp to go to Delft. He was waiting at the bus stop near the particular camp. Some men who came in a Vehicle (PICK-UP) abducted him. The people at the bus stop were the direct eye witnesses to this incident. The incident took place around 10 am. The family members have lodged a complaint with the Human Rights Commission. The family members informed us that no trace of him is found until now .
2. **Arunakirinathan Niruparajh**, aged 25, faculty of science, University of Jaffna, registration number 2002 / SB / 30 was abducted on January 3, 2007. He is from Karuveladi lane, Kokuvil East, Kokuvil, Jaffna. He was born on February 12, 1982 and holds the NIC no of 820432533V. He resides at home and used to attend the lectures and returns home. On January 3, 2007 the family members were shifting their residence from the above said address to a house at the same lane 100 meters away from the previous residence. At about 11 am army personnel rushed to the home of Arunakirinathan Niruparajh and conducted a cordon and search operation in the house. Around 2:30 pm Arunakirinathan Niruparajh came back to his previous residence to collect his book to prepare himself for exam. The family members informed us that he did not return home. The family members lodged a complaint with Human Rights Commission. The university students organized a non-violent protest claiming the release of Arunakirinathan Niruparajh. He was released

after severe torture inflicted on him. Anyone who visits him can witness the severe torture inflicted on him.

### **3. Nagenthiran Rajaluxman – University Student (Registration No. 2003/A/89)**

Nagenthiran Rajaluxman - Final year Student, Reg. No. 2003/A/89, was abducted by armed men who came in a white van. He was abducted in front of the army camp at the Kailasapillaiyar Temple at Nallur, when he was returning home from the University. He was tortured and released after two days.

### **4. Vijayaraja Vijayaruban - Student Ref. No. 2003/A/Spi/357**

Vijayaraja Vijayaruban - Student Ref. No. 2003/A/Spi/357, a final year Arts Faculty student, while he was teaching at a private tuition centre at Chavakachcheri at about 11 am on 29-03-2007, was blindfolded by armed persons who came there in civil dress and was abducted in a 'Powel' army vehicle of the army. He was released the following day after intense torture. He has external and internal injuries.

Some army personnel who are stationed at the Parameswara Junction near the Jaffna University on sentry duty still threaten and attack university students. As a result, many students avoid attending the university.

On 04-05-2007 at midnight, when curfew was in force, an armed group, which entered the campus heavily, attacked the warden and went to the students' common room and smashed the commemorative photos of the past students who had died. They also broke the container in which money had been collected to help the displaced people at Batticaloa and misappropriated all the money in it.

Even now, the presence of the armed group in white van is found on an increased scale in the areas around the University hostels.

If such a situation continues, the students, in the interest of their personal safety, contemplate suspending the educational activities and returning to their home.

### **University Student is Arrested**

**Sivarajah Paheerathan**, president of the Student Union, University of Jaffna; and a student of Faculty of Arts, University of Jaffna, Registration No. 2004 / A / 107 was arrested by the Sri Lankan Army on August 19, 2006. He was born on January 16, 1983. He is from Moogilaru, Udaiyarkadu South, Mullaitivu. He stayed at the University hostel to pursue his studies. He holds an Identity

Card (No.YU005768) issued by the Army. At the time of his arrest, he was at the common room used by the students in the university. On the particular day, the Sri Lankan Army conducted a cordon and search operation. He was arrested in the presence of the vice chancellor (Acting), Prof. R. Kumaravadivel.

## **Conclusion**

Education is one of the pillars of development, prosperity and peace. It is a human right. Every individual must do his/her utmost to defend and ensure the security of those who are working in this vital area.

The UDHR requires every state to protect its people's rights to life, freedom from torture or cruel punishment and degrading treatment, freedom from arbitrary arrests, equality before the law, liberty of movement, freedom of thought and peaceful assembly. As per to the students community, the state has failed to ensure the above norms and has deprived the students of the right to enjoy the application of the principles as the majority of the students belong to the minority Tamil Community. It should be noted that especially after August 2006, the violation of human rights on the students belong to the minority Tamil community have increased tremendously which diminished the dignity and the status of the basic human rights principles. The students of Jaffna are witnessing cumulative violence due to the exceptional collapse of rule of law and human rights violations and abuses. Close observation of the sequences of events stated above and the unleashed attacks on the unarmed innocent student in the North and East show the breakdown of law and order. It is an alarming fact that the student community of North and East are concerned about the human rights violations and abuses targeted against the student community particularly about the inability of the State to identify, or lethargic attitude in identifying the perpetrators to bring them before the court of Law and justice. This situation creates an environment that is conducive to a culture of impunity. The State must not only refrain from human rights violations and abuses but must also exercise due diligence in preventing human rights violations and abuses. A judicial procedure, respectful of due process and arriving at a final judgement, is generally the sine qua non without which a decision to kill someone will constitute an "arbitrary deprivation of life" and, thus, violate the right to life.

Lack of genuine initiatives by the authorities to investigate and prosecute the perpetrators of enforced and involuntary disappearances and extra-judicial executions have demoralised the students community.

It is evident that there has been an impulsive increase in targeting the academics, educational staff, students and institutions in North and East of Sri Lanka.

The dramatic increase in these deliberate attacks and the subsequent loss of life result from an abhorrent tactic of sacrificing the lives of both innocent young people and those who are trying to help them develop their potential, for the sake of political or ideological aims.

Recent international efforts to press for the application of human rights instruments on issues related to children in armed conflict, which have focused mostly on the recruitment of child soldiers, could be broadened. There is a strong case for working to embed protection of teachers and academics within human rights law and focusing application of existing instruments on protection, for schools, colleges and universities and the education process.

A serious challenge now in the North and East is to move towards a position where schools, colleges and universities can be accepted as safe sanctuaries and shielded from military and political violence. This would involve creating student-friendly, inclusive educational institutions, run transparently and free from sectarianism and political interference, that will give all sides a stake in their protection and advocacy work with armed parties and local communities. Schools, colleges and universities could then become zones of peace promoting tolerance and understanding and in so doing aid efforts to resolve the wider conflict.

## **Recommendations**

I try to represent the shock and dismay of the student community of the North and East regarding the failure on the part of the state to curb the continuous and blatant human rights violations and abuses targeted against the students that sabotage the study programme. The law enforcement authorities have not taken necessary and prompt actions to protect the students who are its citizens and on behalf of the students I request you all to take immediate action against the perpetrators.

Pressurize LTTE and the Karuna faction to stop immediately forcible recruitments and help the students to continue their study programme without any forcible political involvement, threat and .

May I request the authorities to take urgent and speedy actions to immediately commence the inquiry into the alleged human rights violations and abuses against the student Community and academics.

I urge the strong intervention of UN, EU, and the Co-chairs of the peace process and the Peace Envoys to request for an impartial investigation into the human rights abuses targeted against the Student Community

The UN should work with Member States to eradicate impunity in the case of attacks on the students, Lecturers, Professors, officials and institutions.

I urge all the Human Rights activists and organizations to pressurize the Government of Sri Lanka, its collaborating paramilitaries and LTTE to use every opportunity to set conditions of adherence to human rights norms, with particular reference to the rights of children, the right to education and protection of both educational institutions and the process of education when entering trade or aid agreements with parties to a conflict.

I request the UN agencies, NGOs and teacher unions should campaign for international solidarity with targeted groups and institutions to raise pressure for human rights instruments to be applied more widely to attacks on education and for impunity to be eradicated. Further debate is also required on how to make the case for embedding protection of education institutions as zones of peace or safe sanctuaries in human rights instruments.

I urge the International Community to develop mechanisms to protect threatened students, teachers, academics, and officials, and to assist them in relocating internally or externally where appropriate

The international media should recognise their critical role and responsibility in bringing to the world's attention the targeting of education students, staff and trade unionists and officials in conflicts and the impact this has on children.

May I finally request all the people in the name of humanity to take all possible measures to bring a halt to the human carnage. May I also call for a stepped-up action worldwide to end impunity for attacks on students and the need for wider application of human rights instruments to protect students and teachers who face threats and attacks.
